

EU observers say will not declare Angola vote invalid

LUANDA (Reuters) - The European Union election observers will not declare Angola's parliamentary elections invalid despite initial problems, the head of the observer team said on Monday.

"We will not invalidate the electoral process," said Luisa Morgantini, who added that the team would issue a full report on the parliamentary election in two months.

Initial problems at voting stations had not endangered the electoral process, Morgantini said.
